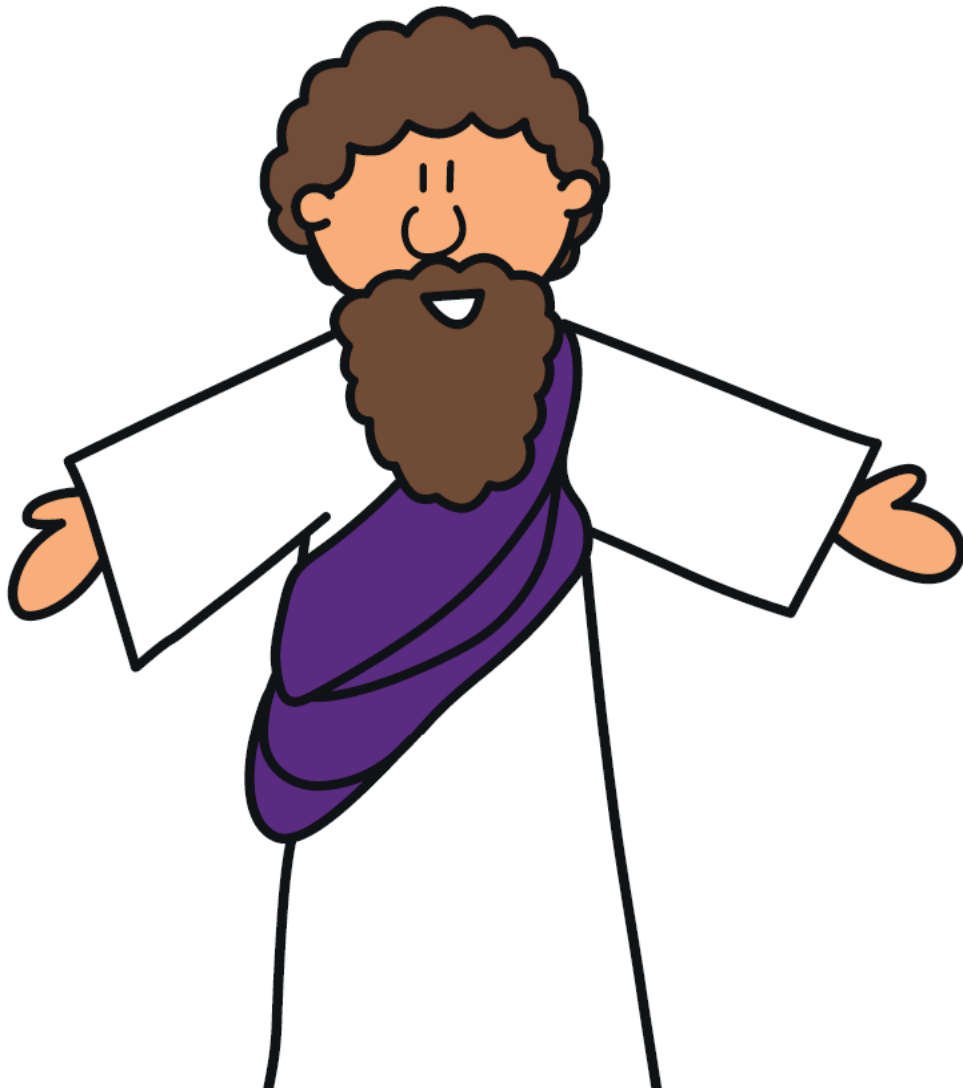


Jesus and the Passover
